However, we are hoping that the construction of the Main Lodge will be far enough along by next summer that we can use the future dining hall as a large indoor gathering space.

## Why Build a New Camp?

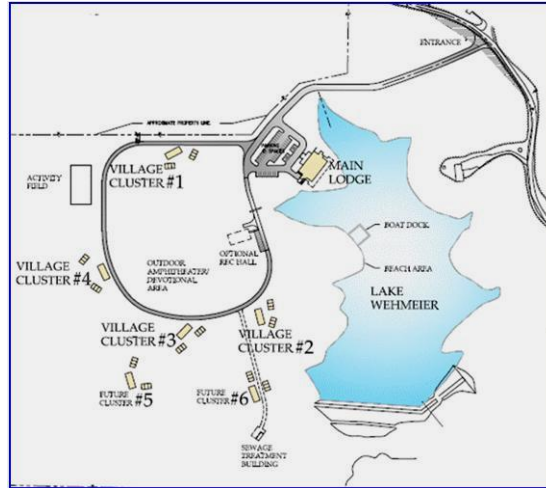
For years, the demand to come to Camp Lakeview has been so great that we have had to turn hundreds away annually. Although this is a good problem to have, it is still a problem! Ministries are not supposed to turn people away! And we hate having to do it, especially when we know how beneficial a Christian camping experience can be for the spiritual life of youth.

To solve the problem, and to provide additional opportunities for future growth, our Board of Directors has decided to develop an additional camp site immediately to the south of the existing camp. This new camp will be called "Lakeview Villages".

## What Has Been Done So Far?

In the fall of 2008, the new lake was formed and the dam was constructed. In 2009, site work was completed, including clearing the trees in all needed areas, leveling the athletic field and parking areas, carving out roadways, and laying all utility lines.

In 2010, Servant Week volunteers and Laborers for Christ worked together to build 12 camper cabins, three bathhouse buildings, and a new devotional area. This was enough to have three complete villages (labeled "#1", "#2", and "#3" on map) operational for the summer of 2011.



## What Will Be Done in 2011?

Before summer camp opens on June 5<sup>th</sup>, we will need to complete work on a sports shed, waterfront shed, and four more camper cabins, which will serve as support areas (canteen, first-aid station, office, etc.) during 2011 before being turned back to camper cabins for the summer of 2012.

Work on the Main Lodge began in November, 2010. A general contractor has been hired to build the "shell" of the building. However, we will use Laborers for Christ and Servant Week volunteers to finish the interior and to construct all exterior decking. This building will not be available for summer use. Volunteer help will be needed throughout the spring and summer.

## What Will the Week Be Like?

### ***OPTION 1 – RESIDENTIAL PACKAGE***

Servant Week Volunteers will arrive on Sunday late-afternoon or evening and stay until Friday afternoon. They will work from breakfast through supper, then spend time in the evening relaxing, and socializing.

Servants will stay in Mohegan Lodge on main camp. Lakeview will provide all the food for 13 meals and will cook each lunch. Servants will take turns cooking breakfast and supper in the camp dining hall or designate one of the group to be the "all-time cook". Thursday supper is a night out at group's expense.

Although there is NO CHARGE for being a Servant Week volunteer, a donation of \$75 per person would help us cover the cost of the food and utilities for the week.

### ***OPTION 2 – COMMUTER PACKAGE***

Servant Volunteers arrive each morning and leave every afternoon. Lunch will be provided at NO CHARGE.

This option can be used for a whole week of service or just for a single day. So even those with busy schedules can help make a difference.

## What Weeks Are Available?

Servant Weeks are offered every week from April 11-September 30. Those weeks that include a national holiday (Memorial Day, etc.) can be shortened to a Tuesday-Friday week if desired.
